

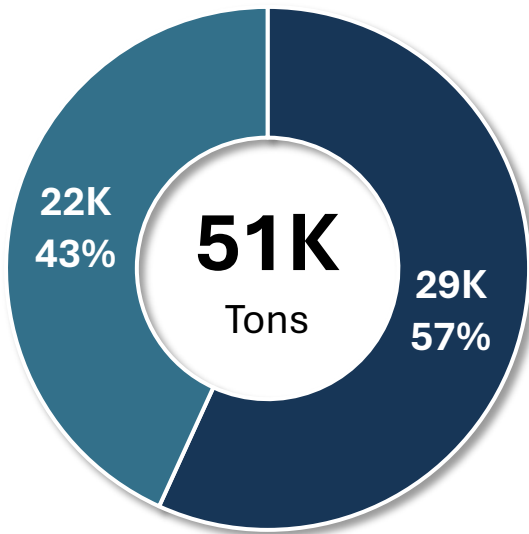

Columbia Metropolitan Airport (CAE)

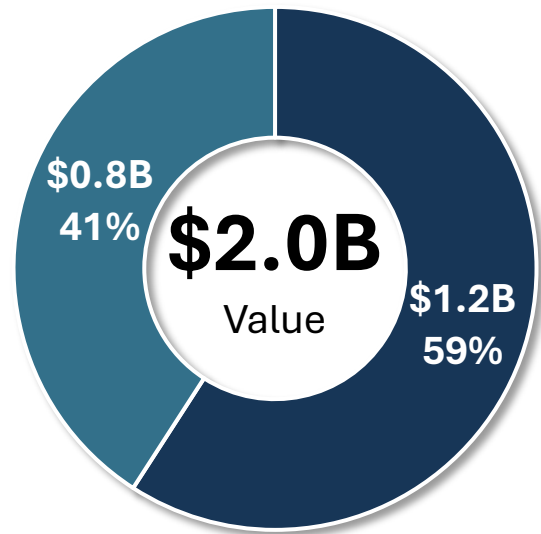
handles the majority of air cargo traffic in the CMCOG region. Current cargo services are provided by Mountain Air Cargo, FedEx, UPS, and Air Cargo Carriers. Through May 2026, enplaned cargo at CAE is up 37% compared to 2025. Additional cargo operations may be supported through belly cargo movements on passenger planes at the airport.

Other aviation services in the CMCOG region are available at the Jim Hamilton-L.B. Owens Airport (CUB).

Master Planning. CAE is currently working on an Airport Master Plan to study current facilities, amenities, and capacity of the airport to better meet the needs of travelers for the next 20 years.



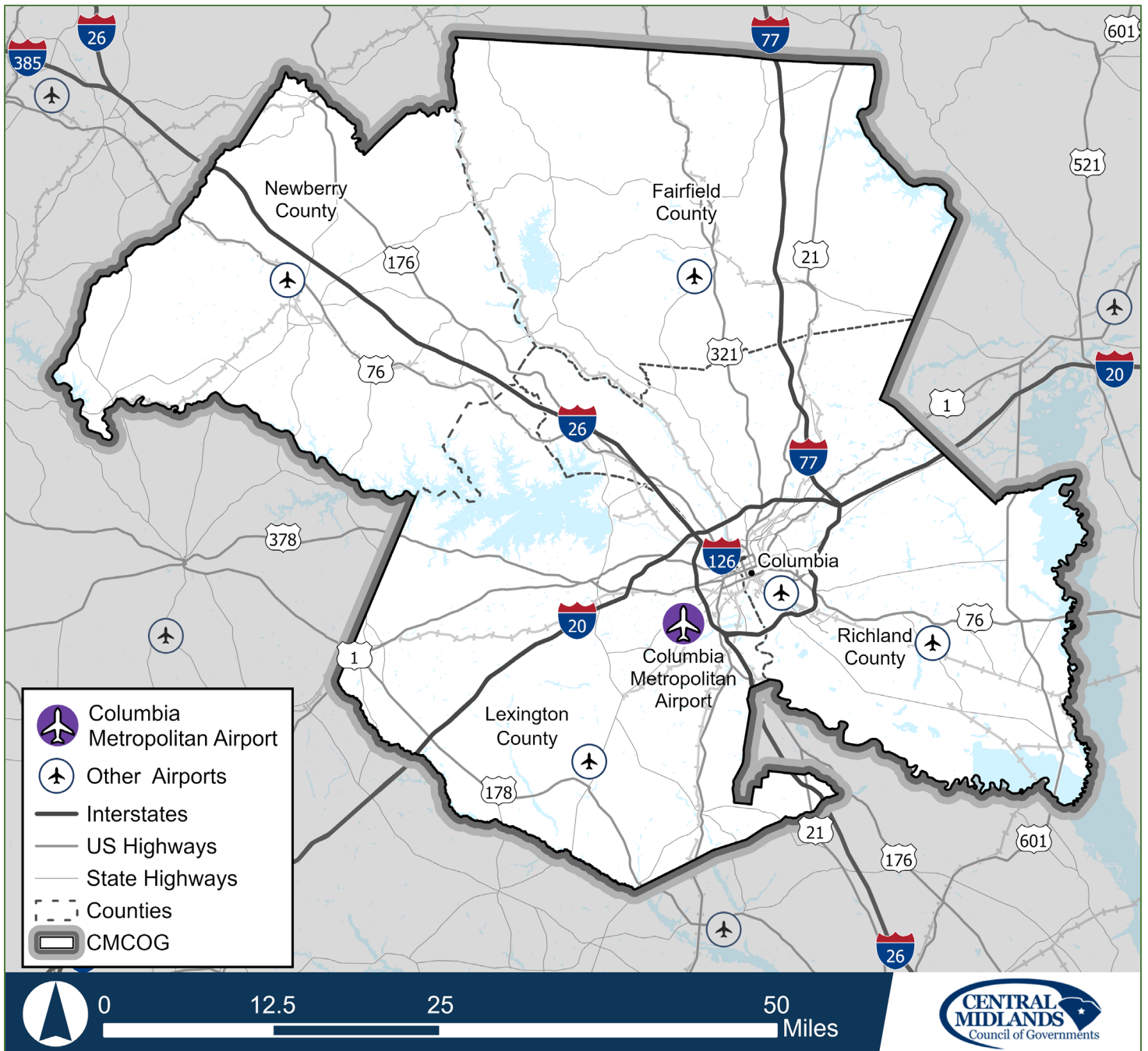
Growth. To accommodate future growth, CAE is considering expanding the runway to 11,000 feet, expanding the cargo apron, and reconfiguring taxiways.
